Steve has 22 years of experience working in and around the Florida Legislature. He was Communications Director for the House Democratic Caucus and was a longtime aide to former House Democratic Leader Doug Wiles. From 2005-2008, Steve ran the Florida Democratic Party's House Democratic Caucus, a period that still stands as the most successful run for Florida Democrats in 50 years.

Widely quoted in national media as a top expert on Florida, the St. Petersburg Times has called him "one of the savviest and most effective political strategists Florida Democrats have seen in ages." In 2008, he was named one of Florida's "100 Movers and Shakers" by Florida International Magazine, one of the most influential Democrats in Florida by Politics Magazine in 2009 and 2013, the most influential Florida Democratic strategist in Florida by the Tampa Bay Times in 2012, and one of the top 100 Florida influencers in both 2016 and 2018 by Florida Influence Magazine.

In 2008, Steve directed the Obama/Biden campaign in Florida, returning in 2012 as a Senior Advisor to the re-election, and in 2015, Steve was a Senior Advisor and national spokesperson for the Draft Presidential campaign for Vice President Joe Biden.

Outside of politics, Steve serves on the board of the Epilepsy Foundation of Florida, Awesome Tallahassee, and the American Council of Young Political Leaders, and is a member of Leadership Florida, Class 31. Steve also regularly travels overseas as part of exchange programs to encourage young political leaders, and speak about life and politics in America.
